This form is meant to convey information from the Faculty Sponsor to the Admissions Committee and will be considered when making a decision on the application.

The sponsor must email this form to the graduate administrator by the deadline for a given cycle when the student applies.

We typically expect similar marks throughout the degree, especially in courses related to Biochemistry (e.g. Biochemistry, Molecular Biology, Cell Biology, and lab courses).
